Membership / Court Keys

Membership application form attached - return to Roger Barham with payment. Collect your **2010 hot pink numbered shoe tag** (1 for each paid up member) and any key from Roger or from the courts on a Wednesday once payment has been made. Membership runs from 1st April to 31st March each year. Payment by cheque is preferred. A deposit of £5 is required for a key.

KEYS WILL NOT BE ISSUED TO JUNIORS - Parents are asked to take full responsibility for their child/ren's behaviour and for the key. *Parents please accompany young children on court and if nets have to be moved please carry and not drag as they are easily damaged!*

Coloured Membership Tags

It is a requirement of membership that your shoe tag is visible when playing tennis on the courts. If you do not have the appropriate tag you will be asked to pay your membership subscription or leave the courts.

Court information

For 2010 there is a single Astroturf court (usually used for 5-a-side football) which will be made available for adult club nights, coaching sessions, tournaments and matches or by special arrangements with Milton Tennis Club or Milton Community Centre (if approved by Milton Tennis Club). The posts and net will not be for general use.

Please help to keep the courts secure by locking the gate when you have finished your game, if the courts are empty. **Please do not lend your key to anyone else.** Please also make sure the lights are turned off when you leave.

Rules of the courts:

- Remember to wear tennis shoes, not ribbed trainers or normal shoes as they damage the courts
- ONLY tennis or netball to be played on courts – no other games
- **Current year (hot pink) membership tag** must be visible when on court
- Help keep the courts clean by placing your rubbish in the bins provided
- Release tension on tennis net wire when you've finished playing
- Please try to wear appropriate tennis clothing
